REFLECTIONS

"Calling them like ${\cal D}$ see them"

As I'm writing this article, it is the day of Epiphany (January 6). It's the day where we celebrate the arrival of the Wise Men to visit the young Jesus, whose star they noted in the skies and followed to his home. "Epiphany" is a word that means revelation or "the reveal of light" more specifically. Think of the cartoon light blub over your head. Perhaps the most famous story of an epiphany is Archimedes who is said to have climbed into his overfull bathtub when the water level rises too high and spills over. He then has this sudden realization about displacement, measuring the volume of an object, and all sorts of mathematical capabilities because of it. In his joy of discovery, he jumps out of the bathtub and is said to have run through the streets of his town in the buff shouting, "Eureka!"

I'll thank you to keep your epiphanies a bit more discrete this season, thank you very much.

The epiphany that came to me as I put together the shape of the sermons for this season was something that had been right there all along, but I just hadn't seen before. And it's the idea of the psalm that we heard on January 5. Being in relationship with God means that we're held to a higher expectation. It means if we take the act of following Christ seriously, then our lives require more than others might. The Bible is filled with this idea: "To whom much is given, much is required." "We must die to ourselves." "Take up your cross and follow me." It's not "Take up your Yeti cooler and meet me at the tailgate." That kind of life is just fine for others, but not for those who are relationship with God. Something is required of us.

I know we want more out of our lives than the shallow existence of consuming content and products that our society is based on. I know we believe that there's more to life than projecting and pretending for those who happen to pass by our physical or digital doorsteps. I know that we yearn for something that matters in this life that God has given us. And by the grace of God, there is more! So much more.

The only problem is this question: "Are you willing do what is required to live it?"

If we were to somehow find ourselves in some sort of stop-frame, where we simply sang the first 6 words, the first 8 syllables of this hymn, and were, for some bizarre reason, unable to sing any more, and if — just if, we could focus our minds on those words and what they are saying, it would be enough to fuel an hour of worship.

Come. An invitation. Join us. Come be a part of this event. Share it with us.

Thou Fount of every blessing. Who are we inviting? The root source of ANYTHING good that has come or will come our way. Inviting him into our midst while we express our love for him and meditate on his goodness to us would be quite enough for one gathering.

Did you know you had an Ebenezer? You knew about your gall bladder, your eardrum and your duodenum, but did you know about your Ebenezer? It's a stone you set up to show you've been helped. That Fount of every blessing we invited earlier has helped you get this far, and you need to erect a monument to that. You didn't get here on your own.

And as you go on, you should be in tune. Specifically, your heart should be tuned to the key of grace.

As we sing this hymn this coming Sunday, we'll use the WARRENTON tune. It's the one that ends with the refrain, "I am bound for the kingdom, will you go to glory with me? Hallelujah, praise the Lord." It's interesting for, the hymn talks about praising God, and then it does it. This tune also truncates the hymn, using only half of each stanza. Here below, I have included the complete stanzas. Read them as a devotion and tune your heart.

Come, thou Fount of every blessing; tune my heart to sing thy grace; streams of mercy, never ceasing, call for songs of loudest praise. Teach me some melodious sonnet, sung by flaming tongues above; praise the mount! I'm fixed upon it, mount of God's unchanging love!

I am bound for the kingdom, will you go to glory with me? Hallelujah, praise the Lord.

Here I raise my Ebenezer; hither by thy help I'm come; and I hope, by thy good pleasure, safely to arrive at home.
